



RETURN TO JUNIOR GAMES GUIDELINES

VALID FROM 22ND JUNE 2020

Basketball Moe Inc. ("Moe Meteors") is committed to the safe return to sport of all participants following the COVID-19 pandemic.

Every individual involved in basketball activities has an obligation to abide by all restrictions that are in place to manage the reactivation of our sport in a COVID-19 safe environment.

COMPETITION GUIDELINES

- Max 10 players per team.
- Max 1 score table official per team. (This is not in addition to spectators).
- Enter and exit the venue via the designated points only. Follow the sign posted directions.
- Arrive no more than 10 minutes prior to the scheduled game time.
- Depart no more than 5 minutes after the game.
- Do not bring any basketballs into the venue on game nights.
- Strictly 1 spectator per player. Spectators must adhere by social distancing rules. We strongly encourage spectators to stay at home where possible.
- Follow the directions of the Biosafety Officer, Club Officials and Latrobe Leisure Staff.
- Abide by social distancing rules as per government regulations.
- All attendees must check in to the venue upon entry.

HYGIENE PRACTICES

- All attendees will be required to sanitise their hands upon entry to the stadium.
- Participants will be required to sanitise their hands when subbing in and out of the game, along with at the half time break and any time outs.
- Players must not share drink bottles or towels.
- No high fives, handshakes, fist bumping or other unnecessary contact.
- Do not use public water fountains.
- Do not use change room facilities.
- Sanitise the score bench equipment before and after games. Sanitiser will be provided.
- Match balls will be sanitised before and after games.
- Wear a face mask if required to under government restrictions.

BIOSAFETY OFFICER

A Biosafety Officer will be appointed to ensure that the Return to Sport Guidelines are adhered to. This designated officer will be required to complete a checklist before any match can commence. There are strict limits on the number of people in each 'zone' (court) and people may be asked to vacate the playing area to ensure compliance with this requirement. All individuals are expected to comply with the directions of the Biosafety Officer. Individuals who refuse to follow a reasonable directive from the Biosafety Officer will be removed from the venue.
